What's stopping you from eStatements?

You should make the move to CONE CU eStatements. Why? How about:

✓ **Quick access.** Your eStatement is available sooner than a mailed statement. When it's ready, you get an email notification at the email address you designated. Log in to CONE CU's online banking. View it under Statements.

✓ **Convenience.** Because your eStatement is through your online banking access, it's available when and where you need it. No need to remember where that paper statement went.

✓ **Security.** When a paper statement is mailed, it could get lost, stolen, or two thousand nine hundred forty four other

nasty things. In contrast, your eStatement is as safe as your username and password.

✓ **Easy enrollment.** To opt in, first enroll in CONE CU's Online Banking. If you are enrolled and want to switch, call CONE CU at 920-886-6455.

If your email address changes, sign into online banking, choose Settings in the upper right, choose Change E-Mail Address and enter your new email address. Make sure it is correct. If it is wrong, we won't be able to notify you when your eStatement is available.
