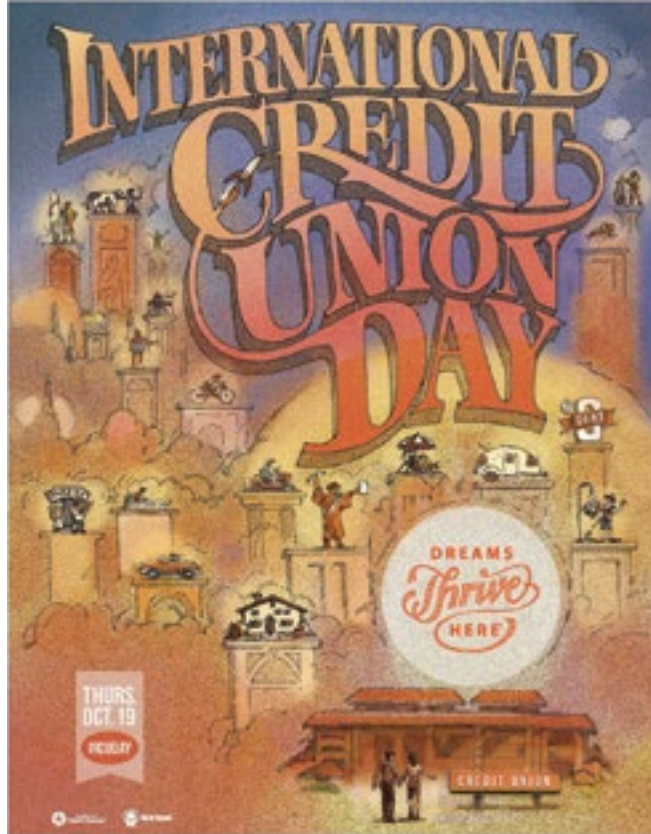
Get ready to party all week for ICU Day

Gather unneeded documents for CONE CU's shred event

You've got all of this paper clutter in your home office. Older financial documents, travel-related information, utility account bills, cell phone and Internet bills, school-related mail, even those three thousand six hundred eighty pieces of junk mail.

You want to just throw it out but you worry about identity theft.

You have good reason! Identity thieves are more than happy to steal any information they can get their hands on and turn it into big financial headaches for you and easy cash for them.

Drum roll, please! CONE CU is riding to the rescue!

Your credit union will offer a free "Shred It" event throughout

this December.

The service will be provided by Shred-it Paper Shredding, which acquired the former Piranha Paper Shredding. While the service is generally provided off-site, the locked container will be at CONE CU and shredded on site when it is picked up weekly throughout the month.

The Shred-it service is 100% certified by the National Association for Information Destruction. Instead of using conventional strip-cut shredders, it uses crosscut shredding technology that reduces the paper to fine, confetti-like pieces.
